I hope you all continue to stay safe.

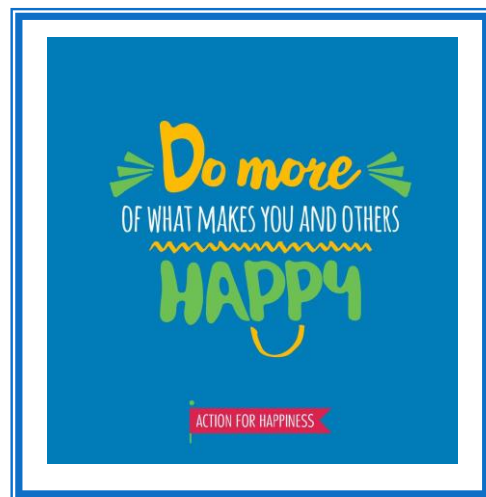
