## Free School Meals

If your child is eligible for Free School Meals (this is different to the Universal Infant Free School Meals for every child in EYFS, Y1 & Y2) you will receive a £15 voucher to spend in a supermarket every week during school closure. ## Childcare bookings

Due to a positive test result of Coronavirus, our Y1/2 childcare bubble will be closed until Tuesday 26 January 2020.

When booking a childcare place, please only book if there is not an adult at home. If you are working from home, please keep your child at home with you.

Recent scientific advice shows that children and adults are at greater risk of transmission in group and crowd situations, so we urge you to follow this advice and only book when absolutely necessary.

If you work shifts, you can book for half days rather than a full day.

You need to book the childcare places weekly. The booking form will be sent on a Wednesday, and will close at 8pm on a Thursday. Please book during this window, as late bookings will not be accepted.

Children in childcare need to bring a packed lunch, water bottle, snack and pencil case on their days in school.

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
