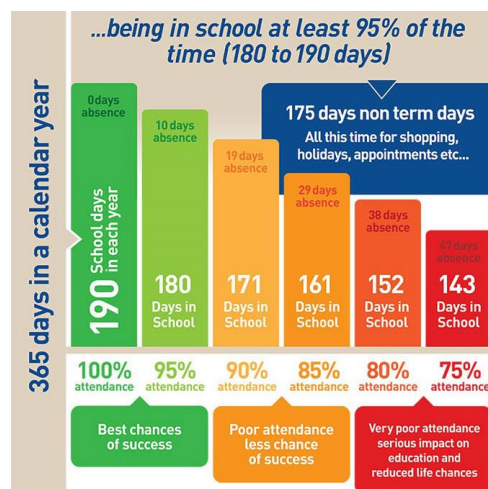
Attendance
