


WEEKLY NEWSLETTER

Teams meetings

Behaviour and intimate care policy appendix

CIT have updated the behaviour and intimate care policy appendix for this national lockdown period. A copy is attached with this newsletter, and a copy is also available to view on the school website 'Policies' and 'COVID-19' pages.

Childcare bookings

Please ensure you only book for a childcare place in school if there is not an adult at home. If you work shifts, you can book for half days rather than a full day. The government guidance states that if an adult is at home, you should keep your child at home with you. You need to book the childcare places weekly. The booking form will be sent on a Wednesday, and will close at 8pm on a Thursday. Please book during this window, as late bookings will not be accepted.

Children in childcare need to bring a packed lunch, water bottle, snack and pencil case on their days in school.

Please be aware that 2m social distancing is in place, and children have individual work stations to sit at and complete their work during their time in childcare. School does not feel like school!

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
